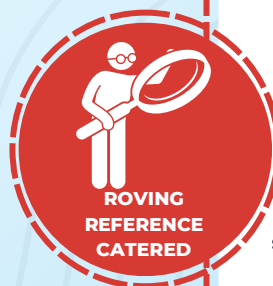

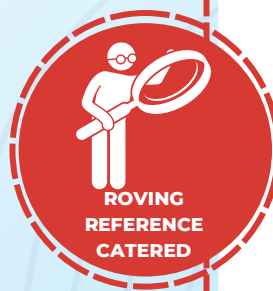
Highest usage, indicating strong demand for physical study spaces. This emphasizes the importance of maintaining comfortable, accessible, and conducive areas for studying.
