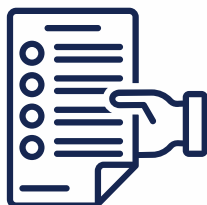

Overall, there is a need to improve awareness and promote broader use of library services beyond study spaces.

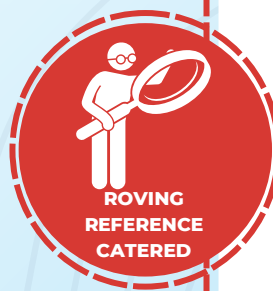
